

USING THE WHOLE PAGE Caption and Copyright line

First, let's start a new file for your card design. For this example, we will use a standard 7×10 inch card. The right side is for your image and the left for your credit or other image.

The center of the card has a bold black line. The left (back side of card) has a thinner line showing the center of the space. In your real project, use the guidelines pulled from the left ruler so they don't show!



USING THE WHOLE PAGE Caption and Copyright line


Click on the T text tool and position on the left side of your page. Type whatever you want to include – photo title, where it was taken, copyright symbol or "photo by..."

You can get the copyright symbol in most fonts on a PC by pressing the Alt/Opt key and typing 0169 on the keypad. On a Mac computer, click Alt/Opt and the G for the copyright symbol.

The Text layers will have the words you typed making it easier to identify each different layer.

You can double click the "T" on this layer to choose another color for the Text.

If you want to center the text in this text box, make sure that layer is highlighted. With the Text tool selected, choose the Center option on the toolbar.



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Now you can move your text into the lower part of the card. To center the box on this page, choose the Move tool and click Cmd/Ctrl T to select the type and line up the center handles on the guideline. Then Esc to remove the Transform box. You can resize, change colors or edit the type any time on this layer.
